Members are encouraged to communicate any concerns or complaints openly.

Expectations for Members

- Adhere to all club rules and respect fellow athletes, officials, and their decisions.
- Embrace diversity and treat everyone with respect.
- Arrive on time for sessions; notify a coach if you will be late.
- Do not leave sessions without coach permission.
- Refrain from vaping, smoking, or consuming alcohol during sessions.
- Respect others and take care of club equipment and facilities.
- Always strive to do your best and listen to your coach.
- Speak up if you feel worried or concerned.
- Bring appropriate kit, food, and drink to sessions; this is your responsibility.
- Wear suitable attire, including:
 - A British Standard (or equivalent) helmet when cycling.
 - Appropriate footwear and clothing for the session and weather conditions.
- Pay training fees before attending sessions.
- Use respectful language at all times.
- Avoid disruptive behaviour and name-calling.
