



LincsQuad Spectator Code of Conduct (Aligned with BTF Rules)

Purpose

LincsQuad is committed to providing a safe, inclusive, and enjoyable environment for all participants, officials, and spectators. Spectators play a vital role in supporting athletes and upholding the values of fair play, respect, and sportsmanship.

Expectations for Spectators

1. Respect for All

- Always show respect to athletes, officials, volunteers, and fellow spectators.
- Refrain from any form of verbal or physical abuse, taunting, or unsportsmanlike conduct.
- Celebrate good performances from all competitors, regardless of team or outcome.

2. Support Fair Play

- Encourage fair competition and applaud effort, teamwork, and sportsmanship.
- Do not boo, heckle, or use offensive language or gestures.
- Trust the judgment and integrity of race officials and marshals.

3. Safety and Compliance

- Follow all instructions from event staff, marshals, and emergency personnel.
- Remain behind designated barriers and do not enter restricted areas (e.g., transition zones, course routes).
- Do not throw objects or create hazards for athletes or others.

4. Zero Tolerance for Abuse

- Any abusive, threatening, or disruptive behavior will result in removal from the event and possible further action.
- No tolerance for discrimination based on race, gender, ability, or any other characteristic.

5. Venue and Environmental Responsibility

- Keep the venue clean by disposing of litter responsibly.
- Respect local facilities, property, and the environment.

- Follow all venue-specific rules, including those regarding parking, smoking, and prohibited items.

6. Alcohol, Drugs, and Prohibited Substances

- The use of alcohol, drugs, or tobacco is not permitted in spectator areas.
- Spectators under the influence will be asked to leave the event.

7. Positive Role Modeling

- Set a positive example for young athletes and other spectators.
- Promote the emotional and physical well-being of all participants above any desire to win.

8. Photography and Social Media

- Respect privacy and do not obstruct athletes or officials when taking photos or videos.
- Do not use flash photography or live stream in ways that distract or endanger participants.

Enforcement

- Event officials and marshals have the authority to enforce this code.
- Violations may result in removal from the venue and/or bans from future events.
