



Mobile Phone Policy

This policy applies to all attendees, spectators, and coaching staff.

To ensure safety and wellbeing during club sessions, mobile phones should not be brought to swim sessions unless absolutely necessary. The use of mobile phones within the facility is prohibited except in emergencies.

Photography and the use of recording devices are strictly forbidden anywhere on the premises, including changing areas. If a mobile phone is brought into the building, it must remain in the member's bag at all times and must not be used in changing areas or during sessions.

Exceptions may be made for emergencies or medical needs (e.g., diabetes management devices), but these should be discussed with the session coach in advance.

Mobile devices must not be displayed or used in changing rooms or pool areas. Anyone found with a mobile device on display in these areas may be subject to disciplinary action, including notification of the police.

Procedure for Reporting Concerns

- Report incidents to the Club Welfare Officer, who will inform British Triathlon.
- If inappropriate images (e.g., nude or partially nude) have been taken, notify the police immediately.
- For incidents involving children, contact parents without delay and explain the situation.
- Do not view or copy any images or footage.
